



Adopt-A-Dolphin Application – 2019 Season ***Help save the dolphins!***

Adopting a dolphin will provide funding for USCB’s Lowcountry Dolphin Conservation Program to conduct scientific studies and for the Coastal Discovery Museum to help educate the general public on how to protect Atlantic Bottlenose Dolphins. Both organizations are working locally to help protect this amazing species and our environment.

You will also learn about the scientific research USCB is conducting on our dolphins and the health of our estuaries through regular email updates. Anyone can adopt at either level. Local adopters will adopt a resident dolphin who stays here year-round and is sighted more frequently, while a visitor adopter will receive information on a dolphin that passes through our waters in the spring or fall.

For \$50.00, Visitor adopters will receive a Certificate of Adoption, a Protecting Lowcountry Dolphins Sticker, email updates throughout the season, and links to scientific reports.

For \$100.00, Local adopters will receive all of the above and a special 2019 Protecting Lowcountry Dolphins T-shirt.
